Tunnel protest

COMMUNITY groups opposed to a tunnel through Banyule protested recently in Heidelberg. Members of Friends of Banyule, Protectors of Public Lands, Warringal Conservation Society, and the Coalition of Transport Action Groups gathered outside Bellfield Community Hall last Wednesday, where Ivanhoe state Labor MP Craig Langdon met representatives from the Southern Integrated Transport Authority, who are involved in the Mullum Mullum tunnel project. Friends of Banyule president Marion Ware said the planned \$6 billion north-east link would destroy the amenity of Banyule's parklands, and would not encourage the use of public transport.
